

POSITION OPPORTUNITY: Director of Development



- Manages identification, cultivation, solicitation and stewardship of donors at \$10,000 and above to build long-term relationships, develop new donor relationships and increase funding.
- Maintains a portfolio of key donors and prospective donors.
- Coordinates closely with Director, Membership and Development Operations, to ensure activities compliment the Garden's membership programs and are consistently communicated.
- Fosters a culture of cooperation and collaboration within the Institutional Advancement Division.
- Builds effective partnerships with the mission areas of the Garden including Science and Conservation, Education, Horticulture, Shaw Nature Reserve, and the Butterfly House.
