Variety St. Louis envisions a world where children's abilities are redefined and possibilities reimagined. In pursuit of our vision, Variety provides children with special needs the tools they need to engage the world around them. For 90 years, we have been removing barriers that prevent children with differing abilities from fully participating in the classroom, at home, and in the community.

We underwent a major change in 2017, transitioning from an agency that both provided programs and awarded small grants to organizations that served children with disabilities to an exclusively direct services provider. Today, Variety's mission is to empower children with special needs by providing medical equipment, therapy, and innovative recreation, and performing arts programs.

1,300+ kids served per year

With this programming change came a shift in Variety's fundraising. We now raise more from individual donors and partnerships, less from special events. The Director of Development oversees a team of two, with a third position in the budget. The Director of Development reports to the Executive Director; two others comprise the leadership team.
